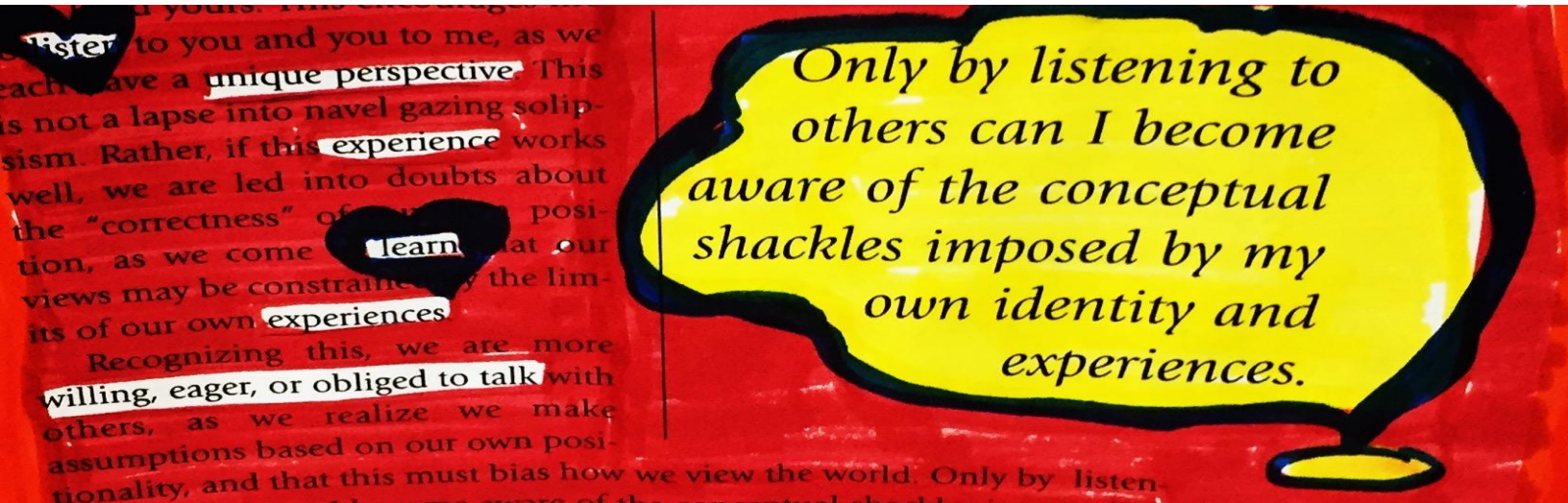


# Arts Learning Community of Practice
