TCAP's Artful Inquiry engages arts educators in sensemaking of California's education changes and the return to post-shelter in place teaching contexts. This program supports educators in making effective instructional decisions as they incorporate inclusive practices such as UDL, culturally relevant and sustaining pedagogies. and the.
